

Resolution No. 431

A resolution amending Resolutions 425 and 430  
regarding surplus property and revising its method of sale.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Forks previously passed Resolutions 425 and 430, which deemed certain vehicles as surplus property;

Whereas, these Resolutions called for the sale of said property at a live public auction;

Whereas, it has been determined that the use of an established listing service for the sale of surplus government property would be more efficient and advantageous to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT:


Resolutions 425 and 430 be amended by striking:

3. The Mayor and staff are hereby authorized to advertise the sale of the vehicles in "as is" condition without any warranty and to hold a public auction with the vehicle being sold to the highest bidder;

And replacing it with:

3. As part of the undertaking to sell said vehicles, the Mayor and Staff are authorized to enter into agreements with public and/or private listing services of surplus government property to ensure that a larger potential audience beyond Forks and Western Clallam County knows of the availability of said vehicles;

Passed this 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 2014 by the Forks City Council during a regularly scheduled meeting.




