

Resolution No. 470

Adopting County-Wide Planning Policies
as required by State Law

WHEREAS, the State's Growth Management Act (GMA), specifically RCW 36.70A.20, requires the adoption of County-wide planning policies by both Clallam County and all of the cities within it;

WHEREAS, in 2017, Clallam County convened the Growth Management Steering Committee that included Councilman Ken Ayers and Attorney/Planner Rod Fleck to revise the 1992 County-wide planning policies in a manner consistent with the GMA and the collective interests of the represented governments;

WHEREAS, over the course 14 months, the Steering Committee met, revised, and agreed upon a proposed revision to the County-wide planning policies that was submitted for public comment and review with the Clallam County Board of Commissioners;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners adopted the County-wide planning policies on 2 Oct 2018 and submitted those to be adopted by the three cities within the County;

WHEREAS, the City of Forks held a hearing on the County-wide planning policies at its regularly scheduled meeting on 10 Dec 2018 and at the hearing there was no public comment received;


WHEREAS, the City is required to adopt these as part of the Growth Management Act;

Section 1. The City of Forks hereby adopts the County-wide planning policies as adopted by the Clallam County Board of Commissioners pursuant to County Resolution No. 88-2018.


