

Resolution No. 430

A resolution declaring a vehicle as being surplus property and
authorizing its sale

Whereas, the City Police Department has a 1995 Ford Van license #44540D that was used for various City related purposes;


Whereas, it has been determined that the vehicle is no longer needed for City purposes;

Whereas, state law requires a formal resolution declaring the property to be surplus, and to define any conditions of the sale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT:

1. This vehicle is hereby determined and declared to be surplus to the needs of the City;
2. Due to the age of the vehicle, and their use, the Council hereby determines that the best way to realize fair market value is by selling the vehicle at auction;
3. The Mayor and staff are hereby authorized to advertise the sale of the vehicles in "as is" condition without any warranty and to hold a public auction with the vehicle being sold to the highest bidder;
4. Sale will be final with the successful bidder having to pay either with cash, a cashier's check, and/or valid credit card;
5. The Clerk/Treasurer will be responsible for overseeing the auction and processing any and all necessary paperwork associated with the sale of the vehicle. The auctioneer will not be permitted to bid on any of the vehicles being auctioned.
6. The Mayor and staff are authorized to further sign any associated titles, registrations, proof of ownerships, etc., needed to transfer ownership of the vehicle to the successful bidder.
7. Further, the Mayor and staff are authorized to take other actions necessary to fulfill the will and objective of the Council to sell these surplus vehicles.
