

Resolution No. 485

A resolution adopting the revised Clallam County Hazard Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) mandated that communities adopt a hazard mitigation plan in order to remain eligible for FEMA emergency relief funds;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the plan is to identify projects that could be undertaken at the local level to help reduce adverse impacts from certain types of events;

WHEREAS, a collaborative effort spearheaded by Clallam County's Emergency Management Division was undertaken to update the 2016 Hazard Mitigation Plan;

WHEREAS, both Washington State Department of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region X have approved the 400+ page revised plan as of January 2020;

WHEREAS, Clallam County adopted the approved revised hazard mitigation plan and each jurisdiction within Clallam County is required to approve and adopt that plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Forks that:


The revised Clallam County Hazard Mitigation Plan, in so much as it addresses the concerns and needs of Forks and western Clallam County, is hereby adopted.
