Please read the following if your driveway is shared with other existing or potential residences.

Addresses are calculated based on the distance from the road origin to the driveway. Each driveway can potentially accommodate five addresses, all odd or all even, with the numbers increasing up the driveway (e.g., 1240, 1242, 1244, 1246, etc.). Once there are too many addresses to meet this standard, the driveway must be named as a private road with addresses based on the distances up that road.

If you foresee your shared driveway exceeding the five potential addresses, it should be named so that it can accommodate an unlimited number of future addresses.

If it appears your driveway will serve a maximum of five addresses, yours must fit accordingly with any other existing or potential accesses to it. Please sketch your driveway, showing the connection to the main road, any existing driveways on it, and the position of any undeveloped lots.
