Resolution No. 505

A resolution authorizing the City to again partner with the Quillayute Valley School District in applying for a Recreation and Conservation Office Youth Athletic Facilities grant

WHEREAS, the City of Forks has been asked by the Quillayute Valley School District (QVSD) to again partner in a pursuing a Youth Athletic Facilities (YAF) grant offered by the Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO);

WHEREAS, the previous City and QVSD partnership was extremely successful in obtaining grant funding for the stadium and track improvements that have been enjoyed by student athletes and community members alike;

WHEREAS, the current objective is to secure funding for permanent bathroom facilities associated with the over \$2-million stadium replacement project underway by QVSD;

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing the City to participate in partnership with the QVSD in the application for a new RCO grant would be required; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary that certain conditions be met as part of the application requirements; and,

WHEREAS, Mayor Tim Fletcher must be authorized to submit this application to the State of Washington on behalf of City and QVSD;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Forks hereby authorizes the Mayor and his staff to submit the joint application of the City and the QVSD to the RCO for consideration under its YAF program and certifies that, if funded, it:

- 1. Will develop a subrecipient agreement with QVSD addressing issues associated with such things as, but not limited to, the payment of costs, provision of the identified match by QVSD, project oversight and management, and audit responsibilities;
- 2. Will develop with QVSD all necessary documents required by the YAF grant program addressing long-term community use and access to all associated facilities being improved and/or replaced; and

3. Will provide, upon request and prior to any obligation of funds being made, any required applicant/grantee information required by RCO to facilitate the award of any grant for this project.

FURTHER, THEREFORE, the City of Forks designates Mayor Tim Fletcher, as the authorized Chief Administrative Official and the authorized Representative to act in all official matters in connection with this application and City of Forks' participation in the RCO's YAF grant program. In addition, the Council further authorizes the Mayor to designate any required alternates and City staff as representatives to act on his and/or the City's behalf with regard to the administration of this grant and associated project if a grant award is made to the City.
