As lead and asbestos was found in some of the existing building components, QVSD has contracted with KD&S Environmental to remove the entire building in an appropriate manner pursuant to the Olympic Regional Clean Air Agency and City demolition permits. Once removed from the site, a new compacted gravel base will be laid upon which a modular building (approx. 1724 sq. ft.) will be installed. All work to be done and completed prior to the start of the 2019-2020 school year.
