

Resolution No. 512

A resolution authorizing the City
to apply to the Recreation and Conservation Office
for a Local Parks Maintenance grant

WHEREAS, the City of Forks can apply to the State's Recreation and Conservation District for a Local Parks Maintenance grant program that was funded by the State Legislature for only this biennium;

WHEREAS, in reviewing the program, its various requirements and restrictions, it was determined that the long-deferred maintenance and repairs to the Tillicum Park Ball Fields Restroom Building would be the best 'fit' for the funding potentially available;

WHEREAS, the RCO application requires "Applicant Resolution/ Authorization" in order to be considered eligible for the grant by the agency;

WHEREAS, Mayor Tim Fletcher and his staff must be authorized to submit this application to the State of Washington on behalf of City;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Forks hereby authorizes the Mayor and his staff to submit an application on behalf of the City the RCO for consideration under its Local Parks Maintenance program.


FURTHER, THEREFORE, the City of Forks designates Mayor Tim Fletcher, as the authorized Chief Administrative Official and the authorized representative to act in all official matters in connection with this application and City of Forks' participation in the RCO's Local Parks Maintenance grant program. In addition, the Council further authorizes the Mayor to designate any required alternates and City staff as representatives to act on his and/or the City's behalf with regard to the administration of this grant and associated project if a grant award is made to the City.
