RESOLUTION No. 518

A resolution adopting Quillayute Airport Master Plan

WHEREAS, the City of Forks received Federal Aviation Administration funding to undertake an Airport Master Plan (AMP) for the Quillayute Airport ("UIL");

WHEREAS, the City contracted with Century West to undertake a two year effort to update the existing and adopted Airport Layout Plan, as well as to rewrite an AMP for UIL with the previous AMP never being fully adopted;

WHEREAS, after numerous on-line, and one in-person, open houses, the City Council held a public hearing on the proposed UIL AMP;

WHEREAS, the public hearing had only Three Rivers Fire Commissioner Chip Keen testifying about the solar based micro-grid assessment he and the Fire District had spearheaded;

WHEREAS, no other comments, public or subsequently written, have been received by the City since the public hearing on 28 May 2024;

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it would proceed with the adoption of the UIL AMP;

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORKS RESOLVES THAT:

- Section 1. The UIL AMP is hereby adopted as the guiding document for the City's Quillayute Airport to include its management, utilization, development, and capital improvement activities until another AMP is adopted by the Council; and,
- Section 2. The Mayor and City staff are directed to utilize the AMP as a basis for pursuing state and federal funding sources for development, improvements, and other identified efforts within the adopted AMP.
